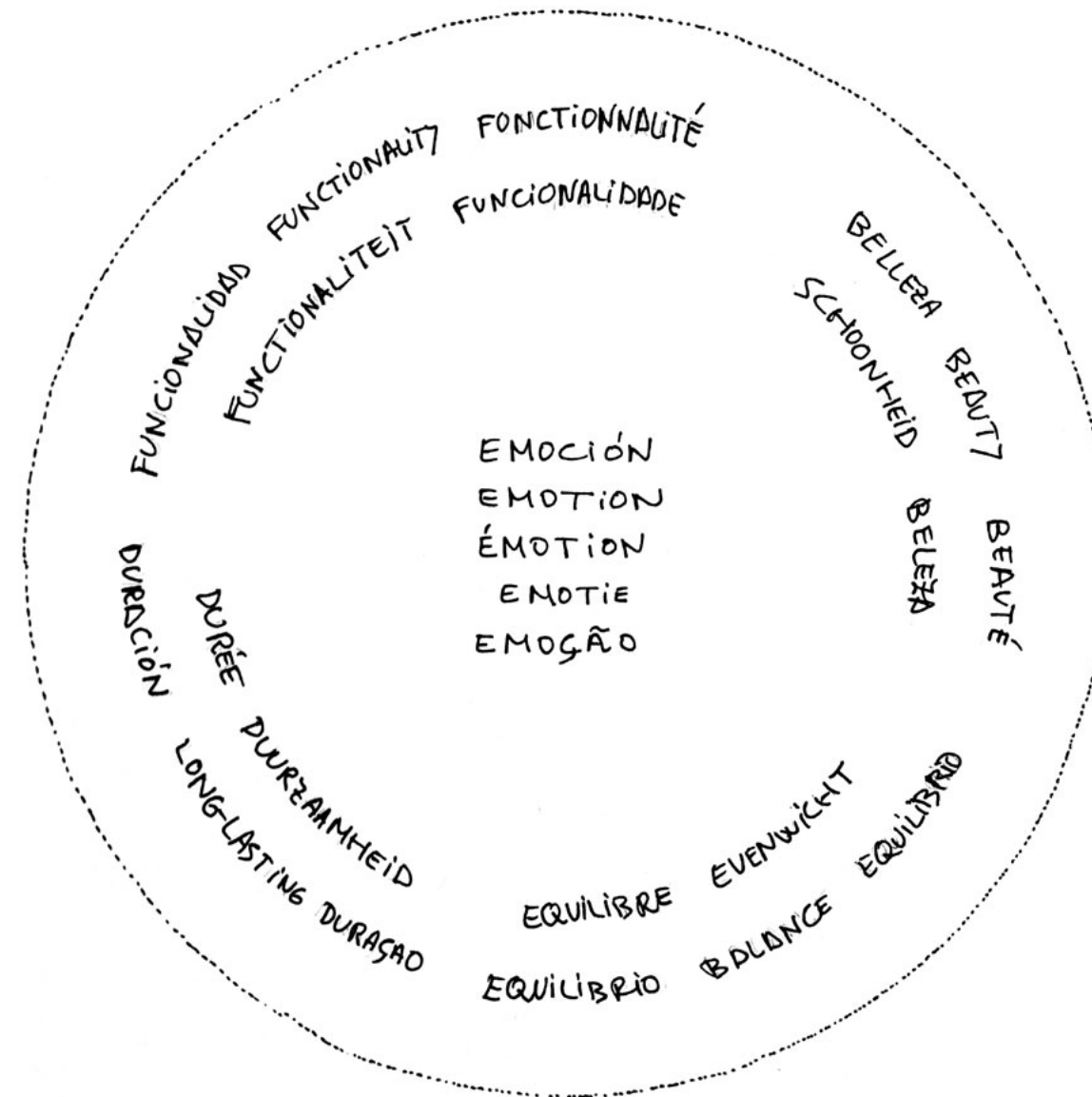

## More kitchen in less space

Reducing the thickness of the fronts and sides makes it possible to create cabinets that are more stylised, lightweight and elegant. This makes it possible to minimise their impact on the house's architecture without losing capacity or resistance.

A glazed sliding door separates the kitchen from the living-dining room without diminishing the luminosity or the visual connection.

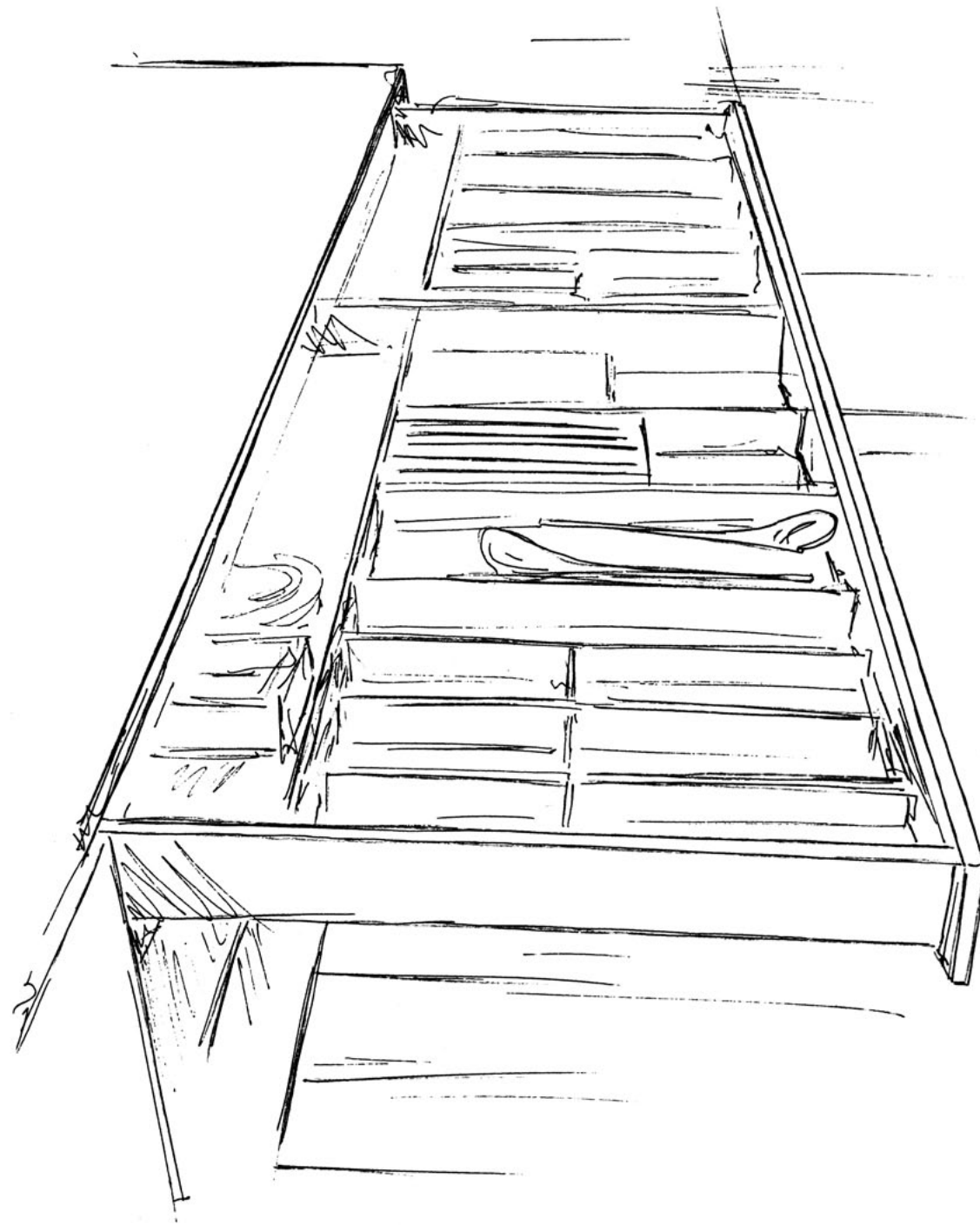




The cabinets with super matt and anti-fingerprint finish are very smooth and pleasant to the touch.







## Exterior and interior beauty

The concern for beauty is not only about the exterior but also about the interior. The surface creates expectations that will only be met if what is inside works correctly.

The interior of a cabinet adds beauty when it is coherent with the aesthetics of the ensemble it is part of but also, and above all, when it makes organising and finding its contents easier.

In the kitchen, organising doesn't only imply that each element is kept in a determined place but also that it is at arm's reach when needed. The design of our interiors, that start with the study of work flows and times, are an effective answer to this need.



The base units, structured in three levels of drawers, make organising and finding the contents easier.





The top drawer, made in olive ash, holds the utensils that are most frequently used in the kitchen. As it doesn't have duplicated sides and uses the base as the support for the accessories, it offers more capacity and weighs less.





The interior accessories complement the drawers, adding order and functionality. The pull-outs make cleaning the drawers easier, whilst others, such as the knife rack or spice rack are interchangeable and can be chosen to suit the users' preferences.







The double drawers make it possible to classify food, tableware and large items such as pots and frying pans. Their sides are the same colour as the body of the unit, creating an aesthetically uniform composition.





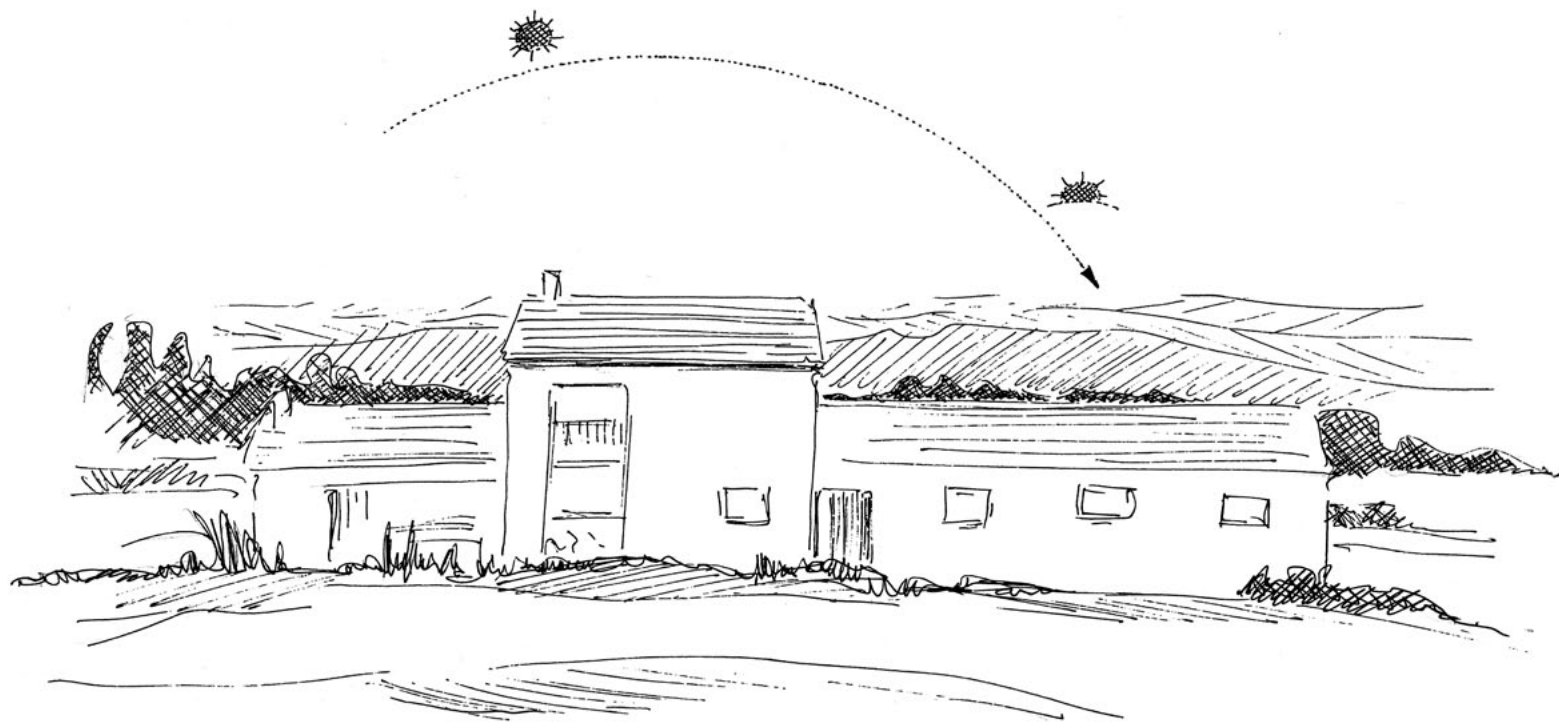
The sink unit brings together recycling bins and an interior drawer for storing cleaning utensils in a reduced space.

## Light, an essential ingredient in the kitchen

The furniture helps turn light into an essential element for working and enjoying the kitchen in comfort.

A good layout of the cabinets favours the entrance of light and its diffusion all throughout the room. The finishes boost or tone down its influence, creating contrasts, luminous spaces or spaces that are warm and cosy. The integrated, discrete and practical, lighting solutions make tasks easier and act as ambient lighting.

The LED lighting, built into the base of the wall units, offers light that is continuous, uniform and doesn't dazzle.

Santos' exclusive LED profile, includes sockets and a slit for accessories. It can also be totally personalised with decorative panels adding more chromatic uniformity to the composition.
